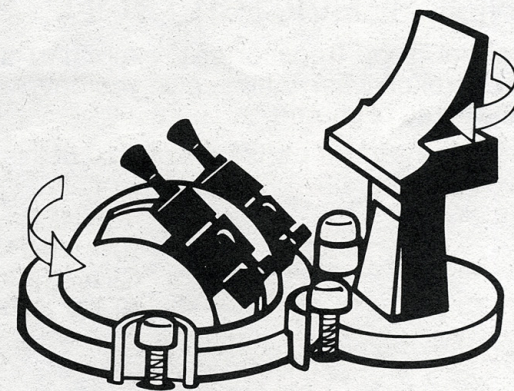
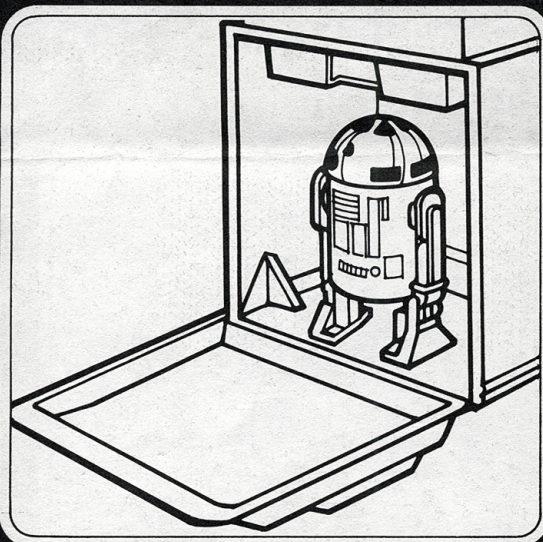


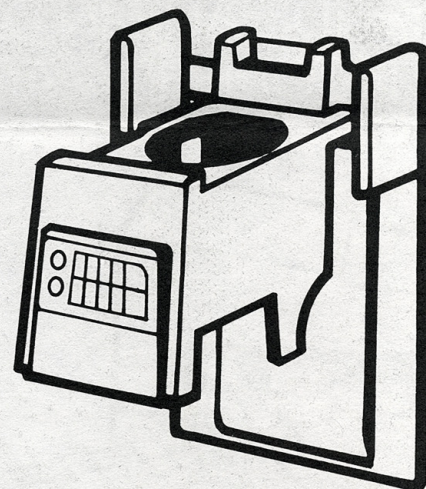
Imperial Stormtroopers™ are transported to the spot where Luke Skywalker™ and Ben Kenobi™ were last seen in the Movie.

A special rear compartment is used to transport captured droids. It looks like Artoo Detoo (R2-D2)™ has been caught.



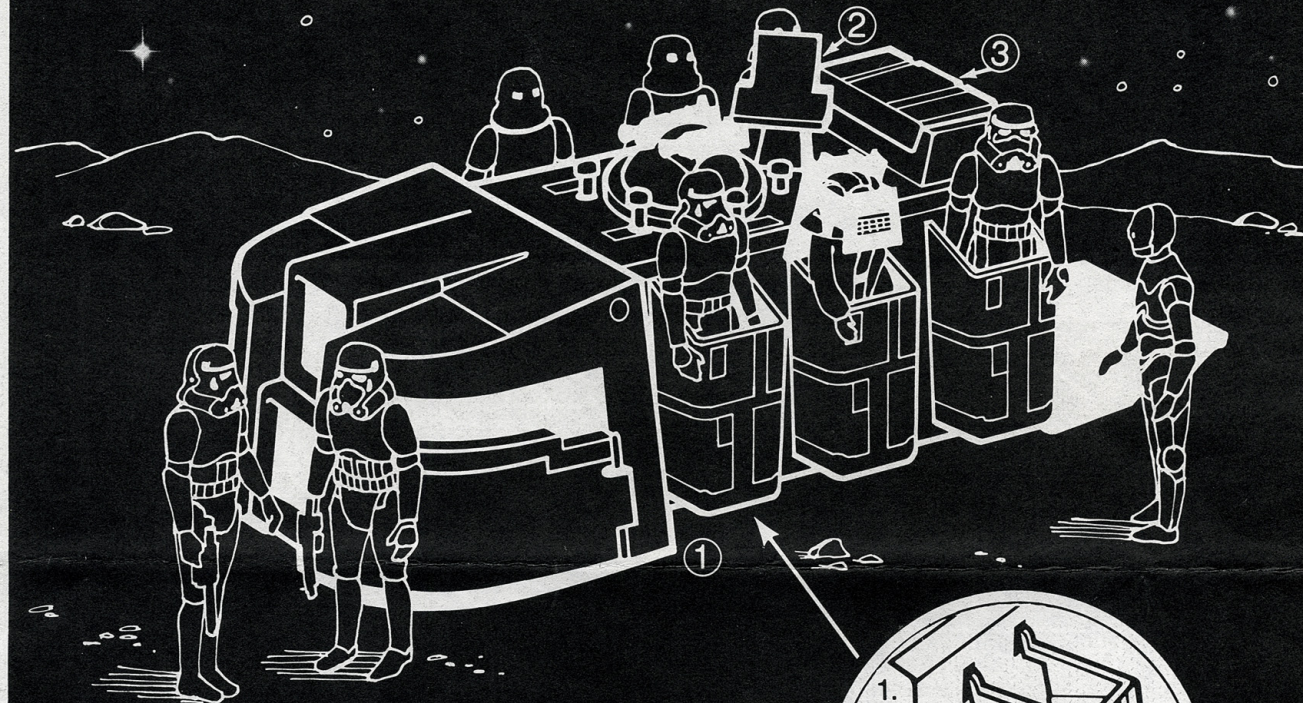
Prisoners wear PRISONER IMMOBILIZATION UNITS over their heads. Stormtroopers use them to try to brainwash those loyal to the rebels.

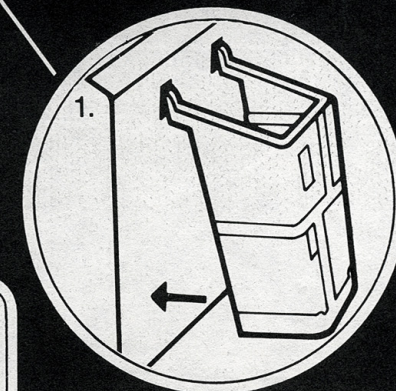

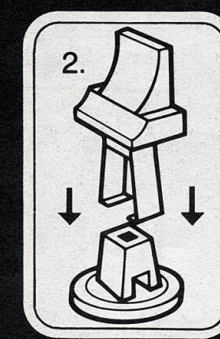


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

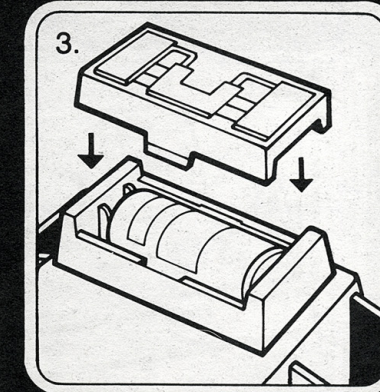
1. First, attach the six PERSONNEL PODS by inserting the tabs on the top of the pods into the slots on the side of the toy. Then, snap the lower tab into place.



2. The RADAR DISH simply snaps onto the rotating RADAR BASE.



3. Insert one "C" ALKALINE BATTERY (not included) as shown. Battery Compartment is shown by ③ on top of toy. Notice one end of the battery compartment has a narrow channel for the battery tip.



Snap the BATTERY COVER into place.

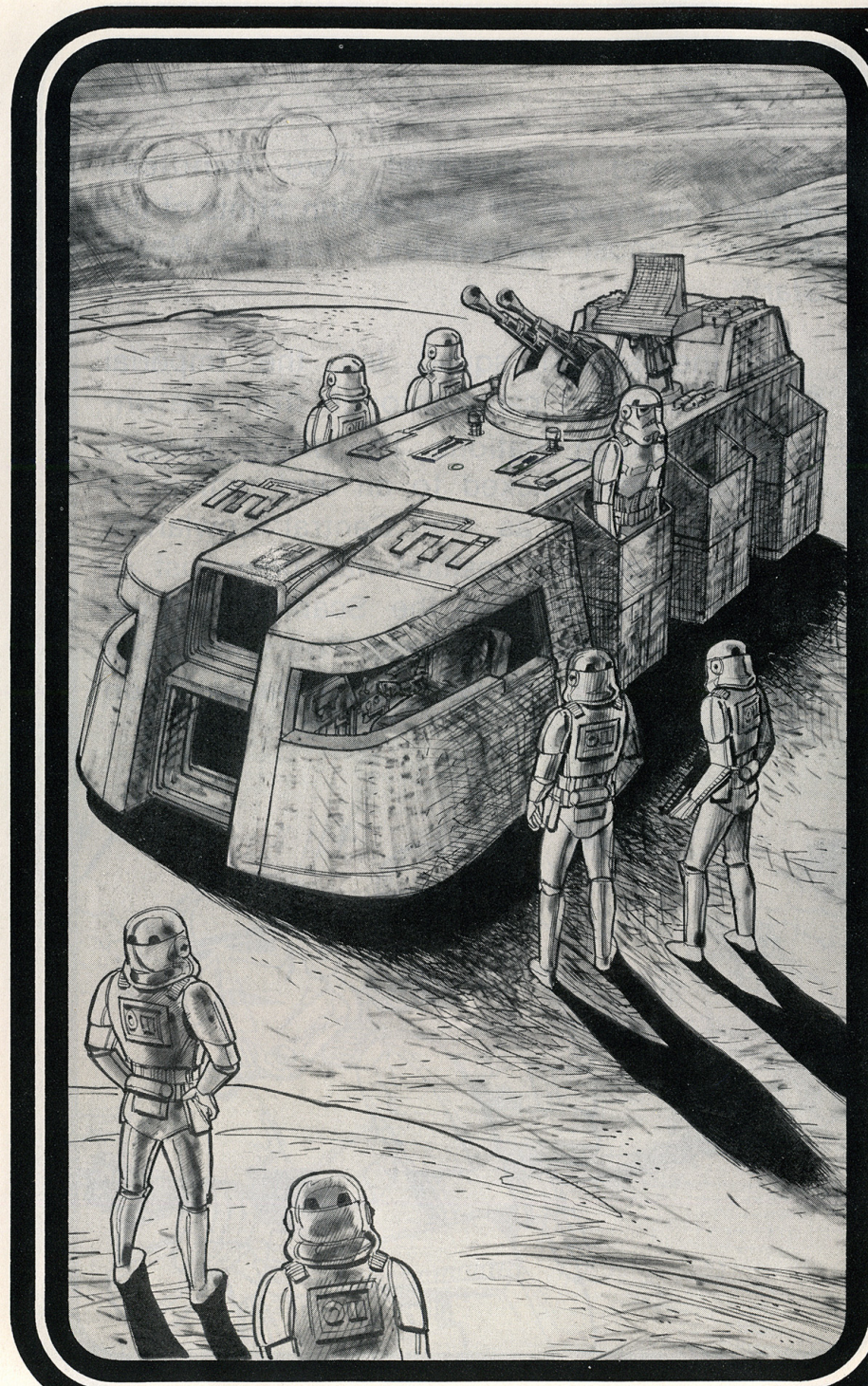


Darth Vader's™ final orders crackled through each Trooper's headset. The words were chillingly clear, "Either come back with the plans or don't come back at all!"

As the search squad left the Imperial Cruiser, a report came through from the on-board Scanning Stations. The *droids'* Escape Pod had been tracked to an arid region on Tatooine known as the Central Lowlands. 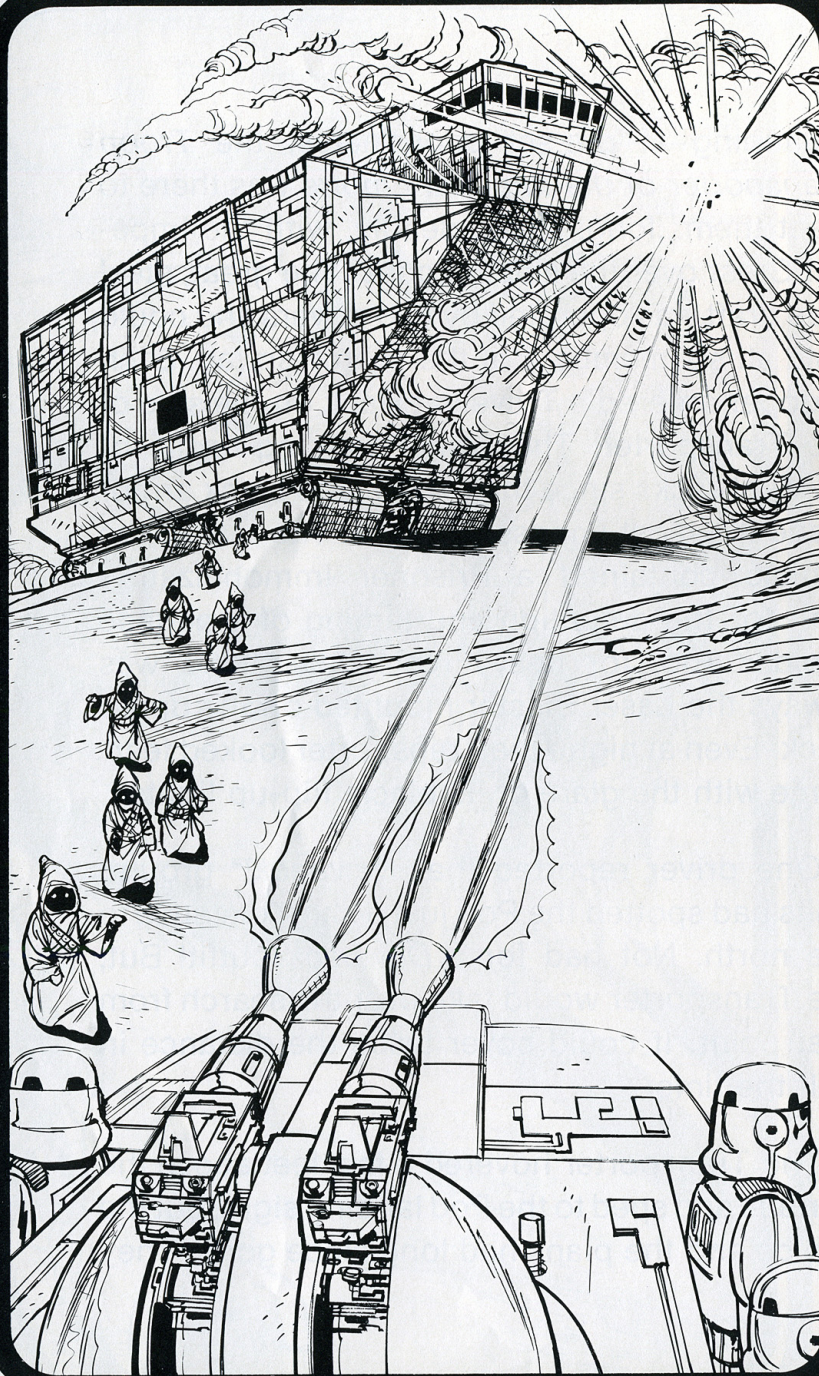




Landing at pre-set coordinates, the *Troop Transporter of the Imperial Empire* was there to meet them...long, sleek, deadly, with the Imperial Crest over the side hatches. The great, steel blue craft was operated by two drivers and could hold all six members of the search squad. Each Trooper entered a Traveling Rack on the side of the Transporter. They rode standing up in individual racks since their white and black armor made it almost impossible to sit. The Transporter hovered a few feet above the surface and sped to the Pod landing sight, but the droids and the plans had long since gone. They

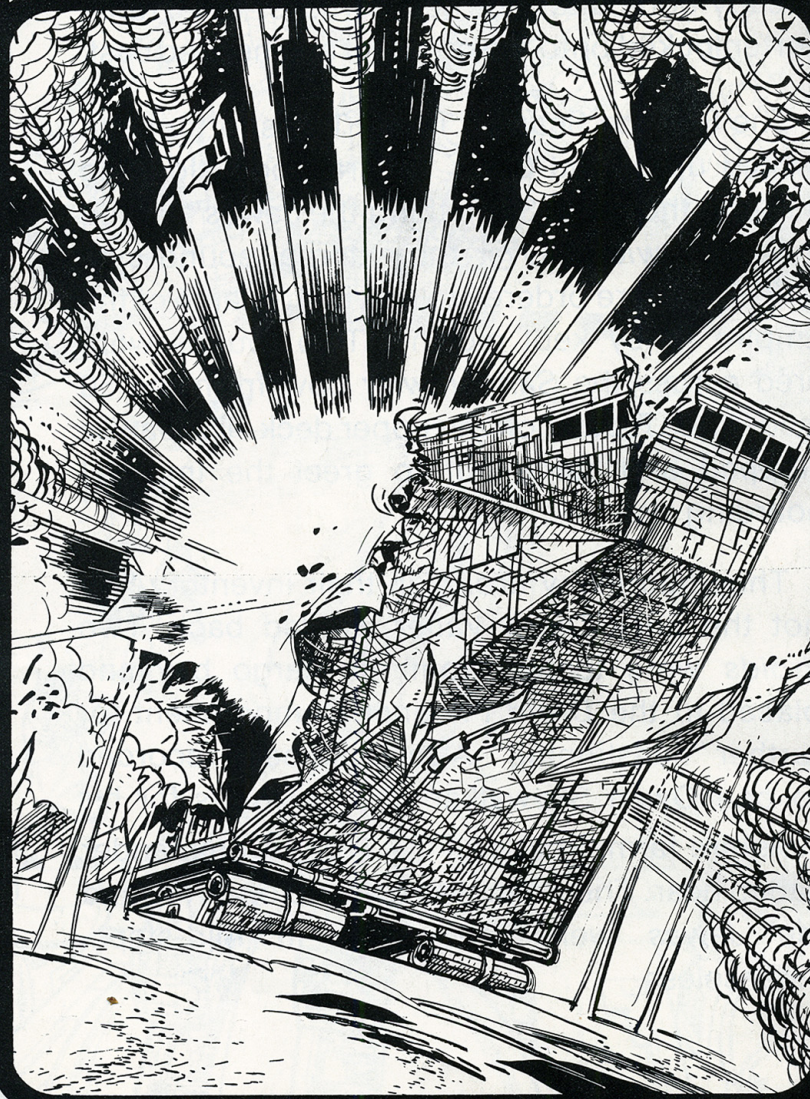
